

Mountain View Middle School  
Title 1 School Plan for 2017-2018

The Mountain View Middle School Title 1 Plan was informed by input from student data analysis, parental input, observation and feedback from classroom teachers, administration and the Title 1 teacher.

Entering Grade 5 students (former Bartlett Elementary Title 1 students) who were actively receiving services in Grade 4 in ELA, math and/or both will be immediately eligible for Title 1 services and support in Grade 5. The Title 1 teacher will continue to work with special educators, reading specialist/teachers, ELL teachers and classroom teachers to collaboratively assess and flexibly group students during universal instruction and for more intensive small group instruction. Additionally, other Grade 5 students who are at risk of failing or are struggling in math and/or reading will be assessed using DRA, NWEA, SBAC, teacher observation, etc. The selection of students in Grade 5 will continue to include a numerical points system. Eligibility for academic services for homeless and migrant students is the same as the selection process for all students. The nonacademic needs of homeless students will continue to be addressed. A more effective monitoring process will be considered during the 2017-2018 school year. The consultation model with classroom teachers has been particularly effective for planning and instruction and will be continued. Parent surveys and teacher feedback support maintaining the current model for the 2017-2018 school year.
