Dear First and Third Grade Parents/Guardians,

November will be vision month here at Maple Avenue. During the week of November 6th, we will be conducting vision screenings with volunteers from the Goffstown Lions Club. They will be using our SPOT Vision Screener that takes a scan of your child's eyes to determine the possible presence of an eye disorder. It is a quick and non-invasive way to complete a basic vision screening.

Shortly following the screening, you will receive a detailed report with the vision results. If there is an abnormal finding, someone from the nurse's office will give you a call and discuss next steps.

If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact us at the school health office. If you would prefer that your child not participate in the screening, please notify us.

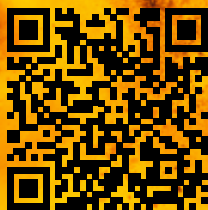

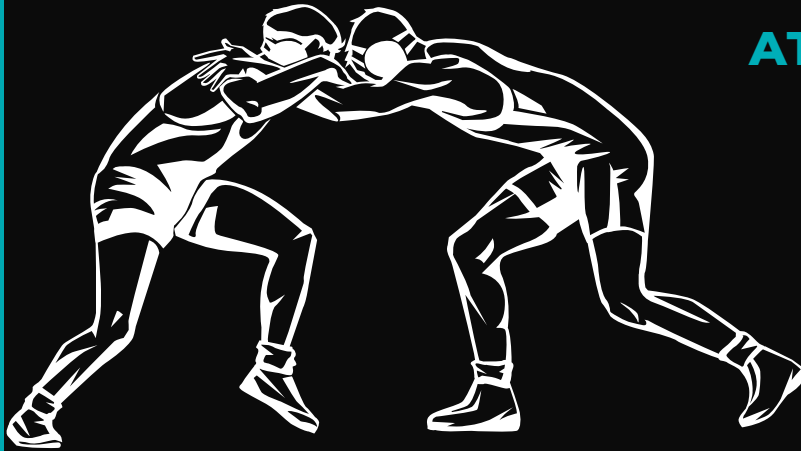

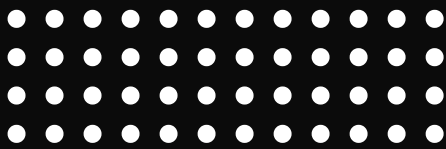
