



2026-2027 Parking Sales Information

This year, student parking permits will be sold online through **BookTix**. Seniors will have exclusive access to purchase permits on **August 17th & 18th**, followed by juniors on **August 19th & 20th** (or, until sold out). The permit fee is **\$125**. Eligible students will receive a personalized email to their **school email address** with a unique purchase link on the day of sales. Parking spaces are limited and not guaranteed.

Before Purchasing:

- Read the 2026-2027 GHS Parking Contract (below) and ensure eligibility.
- Check that all outstanding fees have been paid in PowerSchool.
- The pre-registration form will be available in PowerSchool beginning August 10th, 2026. To be considered, this form **MUST** be completed prior to the sales dates. ○ The window to fill out, upload, and submit the pre-registration information will be from Monday, August 10th, to Thursday, August 13th.

Submissions will not be considered after this time. ○ Current car registration and license plate number are required to be uploaded to the online pre-registration form prior to sale date.

- **Students must have a current license to be eligible. Licenses must be presented at the parking tag pick up. Please read the GHS Parking Contract for details.**

During the Purchasing Window:

- A unique BookTix link will be sent out via email to eligible students who have met the requirements of the GHS Parking Contract and filled out the preregistration form on PowerSchool.
- Parking passes will be sold to eligible seniors / juniors on an online first come, first served basis.
- Be prepared to pay with a credit or debit card via the online portal.

Again, spots are extremely limited. Eligible seniors receive priority. Please plan for the possibility of not receiving space to park on campus.

Goffstown High School Campus Parking Contract

Parking on campus is a privilege. The cost of a parking permit is \$125 nonrefundable fee. Seniors and juniors can purchase a parking permit if all their fee payments are up-to-date and meet the eligible criteria.

- **Valid vehicle registration and driver's license.**
 - **License must be presented at parking tag pick up in the GHS Main Office.**
 - **The latest pick-up date is Friday, 09/11/26. Students forfeit their parking space and \$125 if the pass is not collected.**
- The student must be in good academic standing. **This is defined as passing all classes from the previous semester** (or evidence of credit recovery).
- Student must have appropriate grade-level credits (senior: 16.5 / junior: 11).
- The student will have no past disciplinary issues involving illegal substances (alcohol, drugs, tobacco, vapes).

The privilege of parking on campus may be suspended or revoked by the administration for, including but not limited to, the following:

- Excessive absences (Excused and/or Unexcused).
- Suspension(s).
- Leaving campus without permission.
- Reckless driving on school grounds.
- Illegal parking.
- Driving students who do not have permission to leave during the school day.
- Possession or use of illegal substances including but not limited to alcohol, drugs, tobacco, vapes.

While parking on campus the following rules apply:

- All vehicles must be registered with the front office.
- Parking permit tag must be displayed in the front window, hanging from the rearview mirror.
- No loitering in vehicles during school hours will be permitted.
- No parking is allowed in any staff or visitor areas.
- No student parking in areas that are designated as such.
- Students must park within the lines and follow the designated traffic patterns.
- Students are expected to follow directions of school security personnel.
- Unregistered or illegally parked vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.
- While on school grounds, all vehicles may be subject to search by school officials.
- Parking permits are non-transferrable to other students, including siblings.

Students who drive vehicles on school property must comply with all state and local laws. Parking at Goffstown High School is at your own risk. Any damages incurred are not the responsibility of Goffstown High School.
